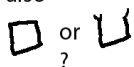

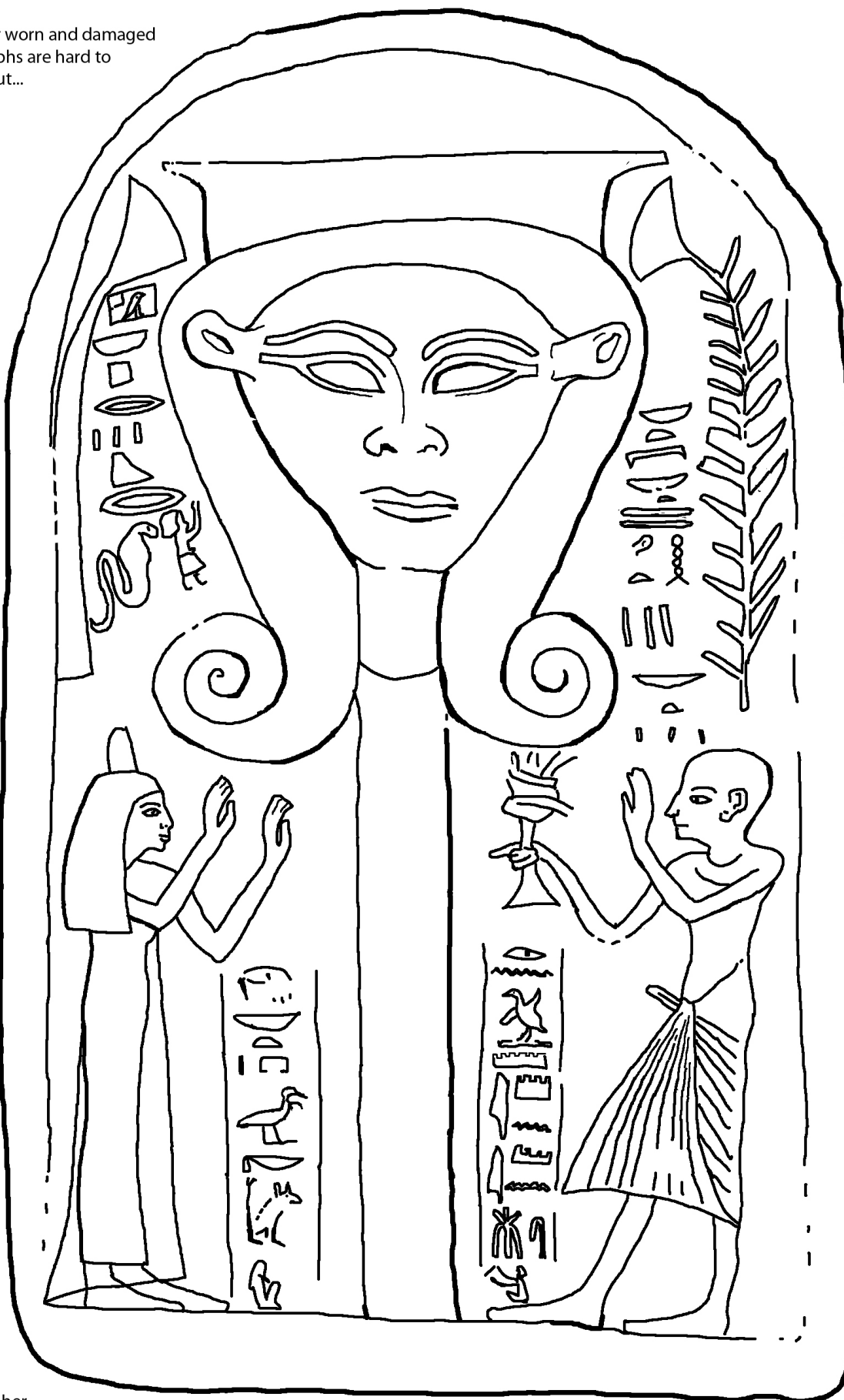


Lady (mistress)
